What's accepted:

Polyethylene (PE) sap line



Not accepted:

- PVC sap line or pipe
- Teflon-lined sap line
- · Drain, sewer, or water pipe
- · Metal/strapping/tension wire
- Leaves, dirt, rocks

Not sure if you have polyethylene? If a small piece floats in water, it's polyethylene.



What you need to do:

- Cut stiff main line into 3-foot lengths
- Remove tees, taps & fittings (or pay a fee)
- Make an appointment to drop it off at the ACSWMD Transfer Station by calling 802-388-2333

Loads that are extremely dirty or contaminated with unacceptable materials may be rejected
